Use the table below for Problems 1–3.

Tina is organizing her comic books. The table at the right shows the number of issues she has for each book series.

Book List	
Book	Number of Issues
<i>Mission Man</i>	48
<i>4th Grade Spies</i>	30
<i>Detective Girl</i>	20
<i>Samurai Sam</i>	24

Solve. Explain why you choose each operation.

1. The *Mission Man* series groups its issues into 6-issue packs. How many packs of *Mission Man* does Tina own?

Show your work.

2. How many more issues of *4th Grade Spies* does Tina own than issues of *Detective Girl*?

3. Tina owns 12 magazine racks. Each rack holds 10 comics. Does she have enough racks to hold all of her comics? If not, how many comics will be left over?
